Structure (played through twice, then repeat Chorus, then stop and play one big end note)

Intro 32 bars (8 bass, 8 drums & bass, 16 with horn hits), Chorus (sung), Verse (sung), Chorus (played), Bridge



## Chorus

Sing through twice

Hand symbol: Pac-man

*Which side are you on? Which side are you on?*

*Which side are you on, now? Which side are you on?*

## Verse

Sing through twice for each of the verses.

Hand symbol: Two fingers up

### Verse 1.

*Storms surge and fires burn*

*But you don't hear the call.*

*'Cause fossil fuels keep paying you*

*Does it weigh on you at all?*

### Verse 2.

*Dirty coal has raised you up*

*But we - can - make - you fall*

*You picked a war with our generation*

*Does it weigh on you at all?*

Play this but try not to drown out the audience who will be singing

Hand symbol: Three fingers up
